





## DECLARATION OF PAN-EUROPEAN COOPERATION AND COMMUNICATION

We, representatives of public and private European radios at meeting in Warsaw on 27 May 2009, have decided to expand the existing cooperation and create EEIG Euranet. The new organisation is formed on the basis of Euranet Consortium founded on 25 July 2007, which from 1 April 2008 began broadcasting programs on European topics in languages of the countries belonging to the European Union. In this way, we want to deepen the cooperation and give it a new dimension that can facilitate more and more challenges.

The mission of Euranet is to inform citizens of the European Union in their national language on issues relating to all aspects of political, social, economic and cultural life of the continent. EuRaNet information on events, highlights interesting issues from an international perspective and provides a new perspective to the people of the uniting Europe. The mission of EuRaNet is to promote European values and standards amongst the inhabitants of the uniting continent. Bearing in mind the national specifics of each country we focus on what connects us rather than what divides us.

The most important objective facing EuRaNet is highlighting the experiences of different countries and communities. For this purpose it is necessary to deepen the cooperation between the media of each country, and that is why we have created EuRaNet - a truly pan-European organisation of public and private radio broadcasters from all over the continent.
